Dear Parent/ Carer,

Shortly, your child will be able to bring home a book to read every evening. These books will be matched to their reading stage in order for them to consolidate the reading skills and behaviours they are learning at school.

Children should be reading at home every night for at least 10 minutes. After reading your child should have the opportunity to discuss what they have read and understood with you. Children in Y3-Y6 must record what has been read in their reading diaries. Children in YR-Y2, parents must record a comment or at least sign the record. This is a great opportunity to have continued dialogue with your child's teacher in regard to their reading stage and progress.

As you can appreciate these books cost a lot of money. Therefore, we ask for the books to be looked after and returned to school so that other children can enjoy them too. If a book is lost or damaged, then there will be a £5.00 charge in order for us to replace the book.
