

Remote Home Learning

1st January 2021

Dear Parent/Carer,

As you will have seen on Wednesday, the government has announced that primary schools in Tier 4 areas, where coronavirus rates are particularly high, will remain closed until at least Monday, 18 January. As we are in one of these areas our school buildings will remain closed. However, school learning will take place for all children and remote learning will start from Tuesday 5th January 2021.

Remote Learning Expectations

Every day at 9am, all children from Reception to Year 6 will be expected to log onto a Zoom call for registration. Any children who do not log on will be contacted by the school. During this Zoom meeting, teachers will go through the learning that will be set for that day.

Learning will cover all areas of the curriculum just like a normal school day and will be differentiated and set accordingly on DB Primary. Children will then have the rest of the morning to complete and upload their work back onto DB Primary.

During the afternoon, teachers will be in contact with groups of children via Zoom to give feedback and will support children with any misconceptions ready for the next day's learning.

Additional Reading Catch-Up

Teaching assistants will also be contacting groups of children to support with phonics and reading. This will be supported by the class teachers but delivered by support staff in school for identified children.

Key Worker Hub

For those children attending the Key Worker Hub at Cuckoo Hall, they will also be logging in to access the daily work set by their class teacher.

Teachers and support staff will be allocated to each bubble and will deliver additional activities in the afternoon.

These group bubbles will be consistent and have the same children and teachers for the duration of the school closure.
